RULES:

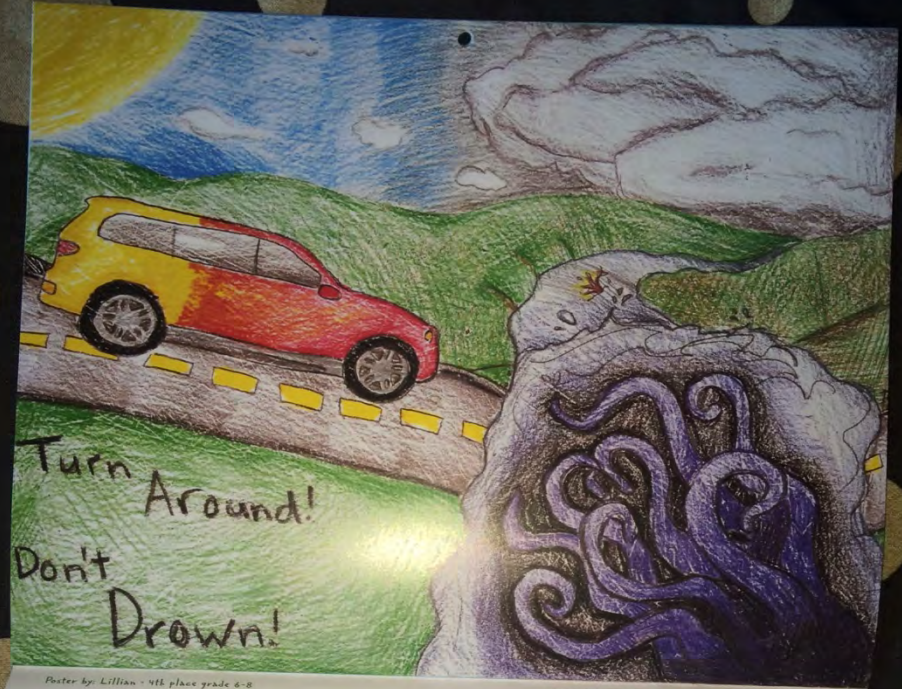
-  **Use only 8.5 x 11 inch, white paper or poster board.** Other sizes will not be judged.
